This organization is made up of eighth grade students who exemplify qualities of leadership, character, citizenship, and service on a day-to-day basis. NJHS meets each month and students selected are required to attend meetings and participate in service projects.

To be eligible for consideration for membership, students must be a member of GCSJH seventh grade student body for at least one semester, have a 3.75 GPA for the first, second, and third quarters, and exhibit qualities of leadership, character, citizenship, and service.

These service hours DO NOT apply for Bright Futures Scholarship hours. Those MUST be earned after entering 9th grade.

Students that have been inducted at another school need to contact the NJHS sponsor and bring in a copy of the certificate and they are automatically a member of GCJ-NJHS.
